

# BOND 2014 UPDATE

Arlington voters approved a \$663.1 million bond in May 2014. The proceeds are helping the AISD make great strides in four areas: facilities; fine arts; safety, security and technology; and transportation.



## FACILITIES

The largest portion of the bond is for building new facilities and updating and improving all existing campuses.

## FINE ARTS

\$9.8 million over five years for instruments, uniforms and music capital



Since the start of the bond and elimination of instrument fees, secondary band and orchestra participation is up 15 percent.



## SECURITY/TECHNOLOGY

New security cameras for all campuses, plus new technology and improved wireless and network capabilities



New technology standards are being implemented in each classroom at every school.



## TRANSPORTATION

114 new buses and 150 new service vehicles, plus the Zonar student tracking system



The AISD has received 79 new buses and 96 new service vehicles so far.
