




## The 30-Second Speech Student Presenter Protocol

Refer to the pre-work completed on your Tutor Request Form (TRF) and give this “30-second speech” to your tutorial group BEFORE the group members begin the inquiry process.

STEP	ICON	DESCRIPTION	Might sound like...
<b>1</b>		Read your question generated from your point of confusion to your tutorial group.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>•My question from my pre-work is...</li> <li>•My question from my point of confusion is...</li> </ul>
<b>2</b>		Share what you know about your question.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>•The academic vocabulary words I needed to know to do my pre-work and to write my questions are...</li> <li>•What I know about my question is...</li> </ul>
<b>3</b>		Share your pre-work.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>•Last night I was able to complete...</li> <li>•This is as far as I was able to go on my own...</li> </ul>
<b>4</b>		Share your point of confusion.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>•My point of confusion is...</li> <li>•What I don't understand is...</li> </ul>
<b>5</b>		Ask your group members to begin the questioning process.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>•What questions do you have to assist me in understanding my point of confusion?</li> </ul>
