**Authorization for Administration of Diabetes Management and Care Services by Unlicensed Diabetes Care Assistant**

Information to Parents: The health and safety of each student is always of paramount importance to every Arlington ISD employee. The District is committed to providing a high level of care to meet any special medical needs students exhibit. To help carry out this commitment, Arlington ISD assigns a Registered Nurse to each campus. The 79<sup>th</sup> Legislature, through House Bill 984, amended the Health and Safety Code to provide more specific requirements for the provision of diabetes management and care services to student in public schools who seek care for the student’s diabetes while at school. The school, in conjunction with the parent, will develop for each student who seeks care for diabetes at school an Individualized Health Plan that will specify the diabetes management and care services the student requires at school. Traditionally, the school nurse has provided any medical care students might require at school. Under HB 984, each school also must train other employees to serve as Unlicensed Diabetes Care Assistants who can provide diabetes management and care services *if a nurse is not available* when a student needs such services. Such services include the administration of insulin or, in an emergency, glucagon. Arlington ISD has trained staff at each school to provide such services. HB 984 further specifies that an Unlicensed Diabetes Care Assistant exercises his/her judgement and discretion in providing diabetes care services and that nothing in the statute limits the immunity from liability afforded to employees under section 22.0511 of the Texas Education Code.

Under HB 984, an Unlicensed Diabetes Care Assistant may only administer diabetes care and management services if the student’s parent/guardian authorizes an Unlicensed Diabetes Care Assistant to assist the student and confirms his or her understanding that an Unlicensed Diabetes Care Assistant is immune from liability for civil damages under section 22.0511 if the Texas Education Code.
