# AISD & MARTIN DRESS CODE 2023-2024 SCHOOL YEAR

Campus wide dress code checks will be done routinely throughout the school year and will be announced over the PA system. During a campus wide check, teachers will review student attire and refer students to the office who are out of dress code.

# **TORSO**

Clothing must cover stomach, chest, back, and undergarments

## **LEGS**

Shorts must be no shorter than three inches along the inseam. Skirts and dresses should be no shorter than the tip of the longest finger when the student's hand is fully extended down the side of the student's leg.

#### **UNDERGARMENTS**

Should be worn and should be covered by outside clothing.

# **GUIDELINES**

- All clothing that promotes drugs, alcohol, tobacco, violence, and/or is sexually suggestive is prohibited.
- Waistline must be completely covered.
- All clothing worn in a manner identified as gang-related is prohibited.
- Students who miss class because of dress code violations will receive an unexcused absence depending on the amount of class time missed.





### **Student IDs**

IDs should be carried at all times and produced

- upon any staff member's request
- on late arrival to be buzzed in
- during metal detector checks
- to check out books in the library
- anytime when in the hallways during class time



# **Cell Phones**

Students should have cell phones **stored in backpacks** or in a **teacher's designated storage area** during class unless their teacher instructs a time for its use.
