Section 551.083 - For the purpose of considering the standards, guidelines, terms or conditions the Board will follow, or instruct its representatives to follow, in consultation with representatives of employee groups in connection with consultation agreements provided for by Section 13.901 of the Texas Education Code.

Section 551.084 - For the purpose of excluding a witness or witnesses from a hearing during examination of another witness.


Should any final action, final decision or final vote be required in the opinion of the Board with regard to any matter considered in such closed meeting, then such final action, final decision or final vote shall be at either:

**Purpose:**

The purpose is to recommend to the Board revisions to the 2024-2025 school year.

**Background:**

The calendar committee, composed of campus staff, central staff, parents, students and members of the community, met last fall to draft a calendar. The committee presented that draft calendar to the administration, and ultimately to the Board of Trustees for consideration. The Board ultimately approved that calendar at the November 2, 2023 meeting.


Later, the District learned that Tarrant County College, who is a partner with AISD, set their calendar for the 2024-2025 school year and it did not align with the AISD approved Spring Break dates. This is problematic for our shared programs including both early college high schools and our four P-TECH programs.

An aligned school calendar is critical to the success of those programs. To that end, Administration is recommending the Board adjust the previously approved 2024-2025 calendar to align AISD's Spring Break with TCC's Spring Break. This change will move our Spring Break to the third full week in March...specifically, March 17 through March 21, 2025.

The recommended 2024-2025 School Calendar is included in the Board packet.

**Purpose:**

To update the Board on progress of the 2019 Bond Program

**Background:**


Voters approved a bond proposition for \$966 million on November 5, 2019. The 2019 Bond Program is a capital improvements program that includes new construction, renovations and facility condition improvements along with capital purchases for technology, fine arts and transportation.

A total of \$802,461,300 in bonds have been authorized and sold as of August 2023, for the 2019 Bond Program. The Phase I issuance in February of 2020 was \$311,104,011; the Phase II issuance in February of 2021 was \$194,414,161; the Phase III issuance in February of 2022 was \$196,943,128; and, the Phase IV issuance in July of 2023 was \$100,000,000.

Work on Phases I, II, III and IV of the 2019 Bond Program are underway. Work continues on Phase I projects with five projects in closeout and two projects under construction. In Phase II, the Playground Replacement project is in closeout, eight projects are under construction and four projects are currently bidding. In Phase III, one project is in closeout, six projects under construction, two projects are currently bidding and four projects are in design. In Phase IV, design work has begun on the Security/Transportation Center Replacement project and design professional recommendations for the remaining nineteen projects will be presented to the Board following completion of the design fee negotiations. Phase V project recommendations will be presented to the Board for consideration in the fall of 2024.

Procurement of vehicles, instruments, uniforms, and technology equipment for year 4 of the bond program has been developed and is ready for procurement.

Administration will provide an update on the 2019 bond program.

- Consider human capital and other resource allocations to maximize the return on the District's investment.
