

Bond 2019 includes funds for Pre-K renovations, additions and furnishings.

The Arlington ISD is implementing full-day Pre-K throughout the district as required by new state legislation. The state will fund program costs like teachers, teaching assistants and other program needs, but it will not fund facility needs or classroom modifications to implement full-day Pre-K.

Classrooms for approximately 4,100 full-day eligible Pre-K students would be created through renovations to existing surplus or through additions, according to individual campus needs.

The primary renovation required for many schools is a bathroom in the classroom.

All Pre-K classrooms will get new furnishings.
